

Pet Doctor (DIY)

- **If you don't have "Toy Doctor" materials, can make some at home! :)**
 - Materials:
 - Bath toys, or any plastic toys you can draw on
 - Red paint/washable red marker to mark "boo boos" on toys
 - Soap + Water + Q-Tip
 - Any lotion
 - Band-aids
 - Can use this nursery song to further support activity:

- **Goals that can be targeted during play:**
 - Imitation of VC, CV, CVC, CVCV syllable structures:
 - Ex: Boo boo, Ow!, Mama, Sh, Rub, Kiss
 - Expanded sentences:
 - Ex: "Help mama!", "I need bandaid", "Kiss boo boo", "All better"
 - Labeling/Identification
 - Body parts, function of body parts, type of animal
 - Action words:
 - Ex: falling (e.g., toy animal "fell down" and got hurt), rubbing (lotion), cleaning (soap+water+q-tip), drying, blowing (blowing air onto "cut"), kissing, hugging
 - Wh- Questions
 - Ex: what happened?, where is cut?, etc.
 - Following directions:
 - "Put bandaid on tiger's foot", etc.
 - Sequencing
 - 1) First we blow air on cut
 - 2) Then we clean with soap + water
 - 2) Rub lotion
 - 4) Place bandaid on top
 - 5) Kiss boo boo
 - Conversation/Turn-Taking Skills
- **Can do activity with various different animals, and then continue symbolic play via putting toy animal "to sleep", etc.**
